Aylestone School is federated with two primary schools with one Executive Headteacher and a single Governing Body. Herefordshire Council have recently approved an investment of £13.1 million for Aylestone School for the building of a new sports hall and teaching block to enable the school to increase its capacity to 750 students. We have also recently opened The Bridge at Aylestone which is a Local Authority provision based within our school environment, providing education and structure for students with autism.

We offer you an exciting opportunity to work with a team of like-minded people in supporting the learning of identified students with an Education Health & Care Plan or a medical plan across Key Stages 3 and 4 at Aylestone.
