- ▶ 96% of the top 100 students of 2019/20 achieved A*-B grades, putting the College in the top bracket for both public and private schools and colleges performance for top students.
- ▶ 99.9% of A Level candidates achieved passing grades or above in 2019/20
- ▶ The A Level Performance System (ALPS), a government sponsored measure of value added results, ranks all schools and colleges for teaching and learning. Hereford Sixth Form College has consistently been one of the top performers in the country over a ten year period.
