You will be leading the Nursery Class under the guidance of the Early Years Lead, nurturing and teaching our young children from two to four years of age in our large and recently refurbished Nursery. You will hold all aspects of classroom management and have responsibilities for planning, teaching and assessment.

- be line manager for other teaching assistants

- observe, assess and record each child's progress and share this with parents including at parents' evenings

- ensure the health and safety of children and staff is maintained during all activities, both inside and outside of school
- attend staff meeting and share minutes in TA meetings as appropriate.

- keep up to date with changes in the curriculum and developments in best practice
