**Re: Year 11 Mock Interview Morning  
Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2021**

Your son/daughter will be attending a Mock Interview on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2021 at school as part of the Careers Programme. The aim of the Mock Interview is to provide a real-life experience of a job interview. This will hopefully give your child a taste of what it can be like and will hopefully prepare them for future interviews, either at any of the colleges or for employment. Your child will be given their interview time, a week before the event.

The interviews will be conducted by various local employers, and will mimic the type of interview environment the students can expect to encounter when looking for their first job. CV's will have been prepared by your child, prior to the interview, and they will be used as part of the interview process. Please speak to your child about this. It is important that a CV has been completed.

Students are invited to attend school on that day, wearing interview attire. This can be a professional outfit of choice, or their school uniform. Students will be attending lessons as normal for the duration of the morning, and for the remainder of the day, and so will need to be dressed appropriately.

Our Careers Advisor, Rachel Davies, is putting together a Mock Interview pack for your child. Your child should receive this earlier in the week beginning 29<sup>th</sup> November. Throughout that week, time during tutor time will be devoted to helping your child complete their CV.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to gain interview experience
