HEREFORD

- ❑ Skylon Park houses businesses in the advanced manufacturing, defence and security, food and drink production and sustainable technology sectors. It is still developing its Cyber Quarter project, which will be finished by 2025.
- ❑ Herefordshire, Ludlow & North Shropshire College is using the Marches Energy Fund to convert two existing farm buildings into a training centre for low carbon and renewable technologies installation at the College's Holme Lacy Campus.
- ❑ A £140,000 Marches LEP fund – developed in partnership with regional transport body Midlands Connect – will be used to support the development of Strategic Outline Business Cases (SOBCs) for transport schemes.
